November 21, 2023 - Halifax, NS

CUPE's Nova Scotia Transition House Sector Committee, PSAC representatives, and local union representatives met with the Transition House Association of Nova Scotia Board to discuss how to achieve wage equity in the provincial violence-against-women sector.

We share a common concern regarding the current state of compensation for front-line staff and have agreed to work towards fair and equitable compensation.



We recognize that a united front, composed of labour and THANS management, is crucial in devising an effective plan of action and collaboratively tackling next steps.
